

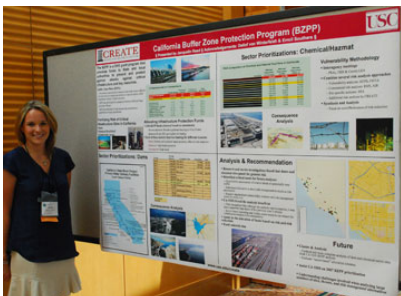
# ASDSO Invites Students to Dam Safety 2009!
